1. FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME AT NAIPUNNYA PUBLIC SCHOOL

15. The prelims of all On Stage items and Finals of all Off Stage items are underway. I request all the participants to get ready for the remaining competition for a better performance.

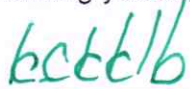
16. UPGRADATION OF SCHOOL GROUND
