Dear Parents,

Cordial greetings from Naipunnya!!!

1. The Inauguration of the new academic year '**Vidyarambham 2022** was held on 1st of June and **Rev. Fr. Jose Puthiyedath (Vicar General, Major Archdiocese, Ernakulam-Angamaly** was the chief guest of the day who gave an inspiring talk on the day followed by the prayer service. Our Exe. Director Fr Varghese Palatty delivered the welcome address. Our Asst.Exe. Director Fr. Christy Madathil, Principal Mrs Rajalakshmy M.P, Vice Principals Mr. Shaiju Abraham and Mr. Gijo Varghese were also among the dignitaries. In Class X Exams**, out of the 121 students appeared 68 students secured distinction out of which 36 students secured 90% and above. Kum. **Sarah Mary Shinto secured 97.6% and became the School Topper**. The students who secured
