Dear Parents,

Cordial greetings from Naipunnya!!!

- 1. The Inauguration of the new academic year 'Vidyarambham 2022 was held on 1st of June and Rev. Fr. Jose Puthiyedath (Vicar General, Major Archdiocese, Ernakulam-Angamaly was the chief guest of the day who gave an inspiring talk on the day followed by the prayer service. Our Exe. Director Fr Varghese Palatty delivered the welcome address. Our Asst.Exe. Director Fr. Christy Madathil, Principal Mrs Rajalakhsmy M.P, Vice Principals Mr. Shaiju Abraham and Mr. Gijo Varghese were also among the dignitaries. Mrs Neema P J, the teacher representative, proposed the vote of thanks. There was also an awesome dance performance by the students of class IX, which was really a visual treat to each and everyone present there.

The World Environment Day was duly celebrated and Mrs. Jelita Elsa Jacob, Agricultural Officer, Krishibhavan, Karukutty Grama Panchayath, was the chief guest of the day, who gave a befitting speech on the occasion followed by planting a sapling along with the class representatives from Std V to X. Director and Vice Principals, were also present at the function. The students were able to imbibe the importance of preserving the nature, for our healthy life and for the generation to come.

Our Principal and Mrs Treasa Mathew (KG and 1 & 2 coordinator) also spoke on the occasion. Our Exe. Director and Asst. Exe. Director were also present on the occasion to inspire the children. There was a beautiful dance performance by class II students which really thrilled every one present at the function.
- 4. The CCA inauguration ceremony was held on 10th of June 2022. Children were able to watch different CCA items performed by their beloved CCA teachers on the stage such as solo song, fusion music, fusion dance, Karate, Yoga etc. and thereby they could easily make out which all items are to be chosen as their favourite CCA items. It was an excellent programme by all the CCA teachers and all the children were so excited to watch it. - 12. Our students made us proud by their overwhelming performance in the CBSE class X & XII Exams. The school secured 100% result in both X & XII Board Exams. In Class X Exams, out of the 121 students appeared 68 students secured distinction out of which 36 students secured 90% and above. Kum. Sarah Mary Shinto secured 97.6% and became the School Topper. The students who secured

100/100 marks are: Kum. Clara Thresia Antony -100 (Mathematics), Kum. Sarah Mary Shinto - 100 (Mathematics), Kum. Suman Biju Kurian - 100 (English), Kum. Stiya Collins -100 (English), Kum. Denna Davis - 100 (English), Kum. Anjana V A -100 (Malayalam), Kum. Angel Rose Prince -100 (Social Science).

In Class XII Exams, All the 76 students secured 1st Class. 59 students secured distinction out of which 11 students secured 90 percent and above. Master Alan Varghese Jophy secured 95.6% (Non-Medical Stream) and became the School Topper. The Toppers (94.8%) of Medical Stream are: Kum. Chesna Johnson, Kum. Devika M. B. and Kum. Devanandana S. Kum. Vasini S Krishna became the Topper in the Management Stream with 89.2%. Kum. Devika M. B. secured 100 marks for (Biology) Congratulations to all!

13. Investiture ceremony of the office bearers was held on 25rd July 2022. Mr. Jose P. L., Asst.
