Dear Parents,

Greetings from Naipunnya!

Christy Madathil, Principal Mrs. Rajalakshmy M.P and KG Coordinator Mrs. Tresa Mathew, were also present in the ceremonial gathering to support and encourage our young ones. Vice Principals Mr. Shaiju Abraham and Mr. Gijo Varghese were also present in the ceremony as we organized I & II Sports Day.

6. Summer vacation for classes KG to VIII commenced on 17<sup>th</sup> of March whereas it begins on 01<sup>st</sup> of April for classes IX & XI. Parents are to ensure that the children engage in some activities related to their studies during the vacation.
7. Make sure that you have collected the printed copy of the **Holiday Project** of your ward (**Grades I – VIII**) from the class teacher as you come for the Open House on 25<sup>th</sup> of March. The students are directed to complete and submit the project on **Friday, 02<sup>th</sup> of June, 2023**.
8. All parents are kindly directed to collect the uniform materials from '**Puthurans Textiles**', opposite old Municipal Office Angamaly. The issuance of school uniform (**both material and ready-mades**) would commence from **10<sup>th</sup> of April** onwards for classes **UKG to XII**. The pattern of the school uniform and shoes will be displayed in the notice boards. The pattern of school uniform will also be made available in the school website. The date of issuance of uniform materials of LKG would be intimated later.
9. Please adhere to the pattern while stitching the school uniform and the socks prescribed for the students. [Grade I to V - **Long Leg Socks**, VI - XII - **Ankle Socks**]. **Socks, Belt, Loop and Tie** are available in the same Textile. Ensure that boys' pants are regular fit and stitched with fleets in case not opting for ready-mades. Uniforms are to be stitched loose enough to be worn for one or two years. **Low waist pants are not allowed** in the school campus. Parents are requested to take care in this regard lest they should be asked to stitch new ones. Tie is compulsory on all days of class.
10. The remittance of term fees may be made through any branch of the Federal Bank. Online payment is also possible for which you may visit our school web site. ([www.naipunnya.edu.in](http://www.naipunnya.edu.in)) The **Challan Forms** will be issued on the day of distribution of



books. Make sure that you know the admission number and class of your ward when you remit the fees in the bank. **We strongly recommend to pay the term fees & bus fees using online options.** The term fees will not be accepted in school office in cash. You can remit the **First Instalment Fees** for the new academic year 2023-24 from **2<sup>nd</sup> of May** onwards. The last date for remittance of the fees, **without fine, is on 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2023.** The details of the First Instalment Fees would be intimated via **SMS** through your registered mobile number.

11. The mode of **Vacation classes for Grades IX, X & XII** for the Academic year **2023-'24** will be based on the directives from the government. The details will be intimated later via classwise whatsapp groups.
12. The **school reopens for UKG - VIII on 1<sup>st</sup> of June 2023.**
13. It is mandatory for every student to wear the **regular full uniform** on the reopening day.
14. The students who celebrate their birthday in the month of May can celebrate it in the school on **2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2023.**
15. Summer Coaching Camps are organized for the selected students from classes **IV to XII** in the month of May to equip them with more technical and practical skills in the games such as Kho-Kho, Football, Basketball, Cricket, and Volleyball. The coaching will be conducted from **2<sup>nd</sup> of May to 31<sup>st</sup> May 2023 (Monday to Friday, 7.00am - 8.30am).**
16. The dates for issue of books are given below. The timing is **9:00 am to 3:00 pm.** Please note the date and timing allotted for your ward and collect the same on that day itself. In case you fail to collect the books on these appointed dates due to unforeseen reasons, you can collect them only on **30th May 2023.**
